ADMINISTATOR CHECKLIST

Set up an implementation team

This team should establish communication channels with parents, teachers, and students, to communicate expectations.

Plan how students will connect from home

Some students may not have reliable internet or access to devices from home. Work with parents and your technology team to identify possible solutions or to provide devices.

Create a Content Library

Prepare a list of content or <u>create your own content library</u> on Knowledgehook to provide material for learning remotely.

Share Knowledgehook with your Teachers

Have your teachers <u>create their free accounts</u> and begin accessing your content library.

Discuss Best Practices for Remote Learning

Talk with your teachers to identify what is working well for managing content, communication, and engaging students.
